GRANTS FOR PARTICIPANTS OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

VLIR UOS COOPERATION FUNDS FOR PARTICIPANTS OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

The Flemish Interuniversity Council (VLIR) has allocated to the EAAE 2008 congress a budget to cover registration fees and to reimburse either travelling costs or accommodation for a number of participants from a list of developing countries (see list attached). The maximum reimbursement per person is 800 euro. Only applicants presenting a accepted paper or poster at the EAAE 2008 congress can qualify for the grant.

Candidates should send the Grant application form, accompanied by the following information by e-mail, fax or postal mail to the congress secretariat:

- Grant application form
- Short C.V. (1 A4-format page) containing:
 - A list of publications and presentations at scientific meetings.
- Title of the paper/poster (with proof of submission)
- Letter of institute/supervisor justifying that no other funds are available for the scientist to attend the EAAE 2008 congress in Ghent

- 2° Acceptance of poster by the EAAE scientific committee
- 3° Age of applicant
- 4° Diversity of origin
- 5° Curriculum vitae
